What the Fatwas were and how they were passed?

Fatwa, is a non-binding (in secular rule), but binding religious (faith), in providing interpretations and teachings, issued by an Islamic jurist or mufti

The Biodiversity Fatwa No 4 2014

- Fatwa for the Conservation of Endangered Animals for the Balance of Ecosystems No 4/2014, provides important clauses:
 - Killing, harming, assaulting, hunting and/or engaging in other activities which threaten endangered species with extinction are **forbidden**, except for cases allowed under shariah, such as self defense;
 - Illegal hunting and/or illegal trading of endangered **species are haram** (unlawful).

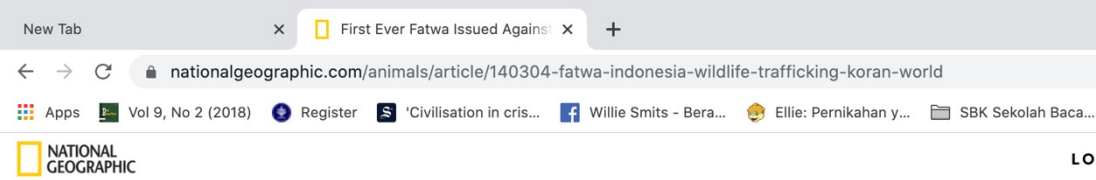
The Fatwa on Protection of Endangered species to maintain the balanced ecosystem



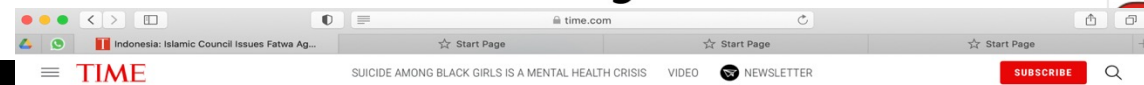

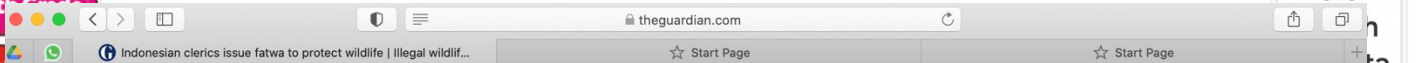

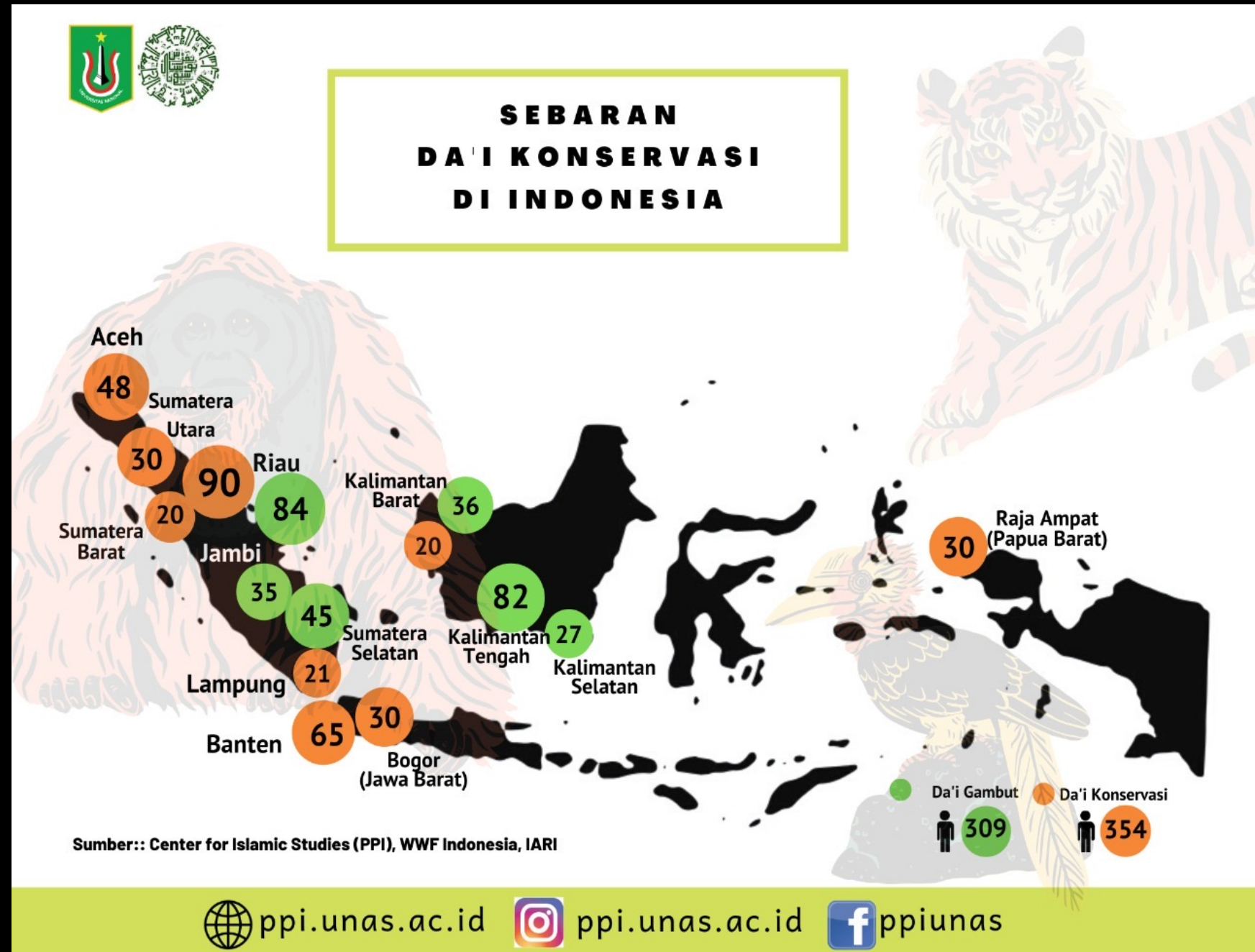
The trained Imams
